Professor Peter Cameron is the Academic Director of The Alfred Emergency and Trauma Centre and Professor of Emergency at Monash University's School of Public Health and Preventive Medicine. He is past president of the International Federation for Emergency Medicine and the Australian College for Emergency Medicine.
